During our English lessons, we will write for a variety of purposes including a traditional tale, setting description, diary entry and a trickster tale.

Place value:

 Read roman numerals to 1000. Read, write, order, round and compare numbers to 1,000,000.

Addition and subtraction:

 Count forwards and backwards with positive and negative numbers. Add and subtract four-digit numbers. Solve multi-step problems in contexts. Use rounding to check calculations. Add and subtract numbers mentally.

Multiplication and division:

 Identify multiples and factors. Know and use prime numbers, prime factors and composite numbers.

- Locate countries of Europe and their capital cities.
- Locate the Prime Meridian and talk about its function.
- Compare the climate, features and human geography within Eastern Europe.
