Our school has once again signed up to the Safe and Active Schools Programme 2024-2025. As part of the programme all children will be receiving age-appropriate road safety sessions, and we will also be participating in and promoting active travel.

Last year we achieved gold award. This year we are going to be working towards our platinum award. We recognise how important messaging is for our children. Your children copy your actions, and your behaviour serves as a powerful role model. We would like to ask all our families to model the safest behaviours near the road for children to copy and make good choices around travelling actively on the school run.

We will be sharing messages and ideas from the Safe and Active Schools team and further information about the children's road safety learning in school throughout the year.

Attendance

Safeguarding of all our children is a very important part of the school commitment to our families and monitoring attendance forms part of this duty of care. Therefore, in line with our Safeguarding Policy, staff from our Safeguarding Team routinely carry out brief doorstep home visits to say hello to children and to offer our support. This will happen if we have not heard from a family about why their child is absent that day, or if the child has been absent for a number of consecutive days. To ensure this is most effective, we ask that if your child is going to be absent from school, you notify the office and provide

the reason for absence before 9:45am on each day of absence. If your child is off school for a few days in a row, our staff may ask if your child is at your home address or with a family member so that the home visit can be carried out in the most time efficient manner. As always, if you would like more information on this please speak to any member of our Inclusion Team.



If you think that a child is at immediate risk, contact the police immediately by dialling **999**.

Safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children is everyone's responsibility

What will happen if I report child abuse?

Childcare agencies believe that children are best cared for by their parents. Children are rarely removed from their parents and most families are given help and support. Social Workers can only remove children from home with a court order and only after they have demonstrated that the child is at serious risk. If you would like to speak to someone in school about your concerns the above members of staff are Designated Safeguarding Leads and will be happy to listen to your concerns and take the appropriate steps to safeguard a child.
